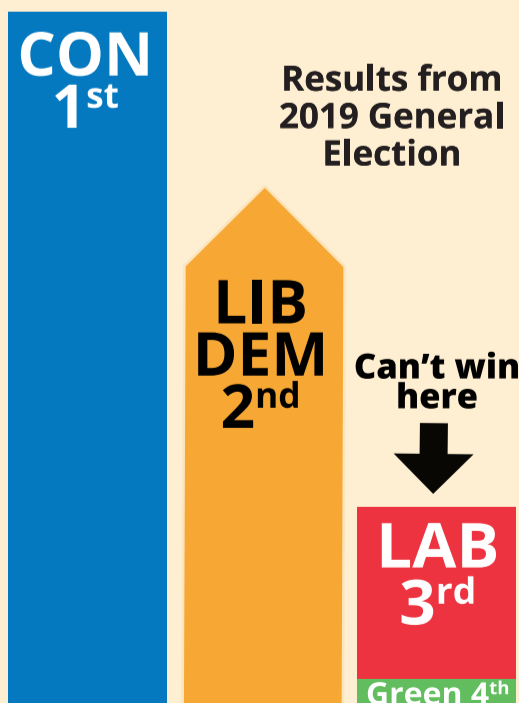
It's Lib Dem or Conservative in Woking:

LIB DEMS TACKLE CONSERVATIVES' FINANCIAL MESS

Since taking control of Woking Borough Council, the Lib Dems have uncovered the true extent of the debt crisis left by fifteen years of Conservative rule.

With total debt approaching £2.4bn, Woking has the third highest borrowing of all local authorities in England and Wales, and requires £56m per year in interest payments alone.

The Lib Dems are working hard to get Woking's finances under control and have set a tough but balanced budget for 2023-24, but the mess left by years of Conservative mismanagement means we are not out of the woods yet.
